A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HESPERIA, CALIFORNIA, SPECIFYING THE INTENDED PURPOSE FOR THE 2013 ALLOCATION FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG)

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) provides for supplemental funding to reduce crime and improve public safety; and

WHEREAS, the funding is administered by the Bureau of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the revenues received from this grant are allocated to qualifying agencies for specific purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HESPERIA AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. All facts set forth in this resolution are true and correct.
- Section 2. That the City Council approves the appropriation of \$21,485 for the City of Hesperia from the Bureau of Justice, Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant, for the purpose of partially funding operational overtime, training and equipment.
- Section 3. The Director of Management Services shall establish a mechanism to provide for the receipt and expenditure of all allocated monies under the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
- Section 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
