

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HESPERIA, CALIFORNIA, TO APPROPRIATE \$34,900 OF PRIOR FISCAL YEAR CARRYOVER GRANT FUNDS TO FUND 504 – HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL – MAIN ST. & SULTANA ST./TIMBERLANE AVE. PROJECT, C.O. NO. 7159.

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant in the amount of \$899,300 for the Traffic Signal – Main St. and Sultana St./Timberlane Ave. project, C.O. No. 7159 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Project was constructed to improve traffic operations and enhance safety for motorists and pedestrians at the intersection; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2024, the City Council awarded the construction contract for the Project to DBX, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, construction of the Project was completed in March 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Capital Improvement Budget by appropriating \$34,900 in prior fiscal year carryover grant funds to Fund 504 - HSIP for the Project to reconcile grant expenditures consistent with the grant award.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HESPERIA CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Fiscal Year 2025-26 Capital Improvement Program Budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$34,900 of prior year carryover grant funds to Account No. 504-29-700-7159-8000.

Section 2. That City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
