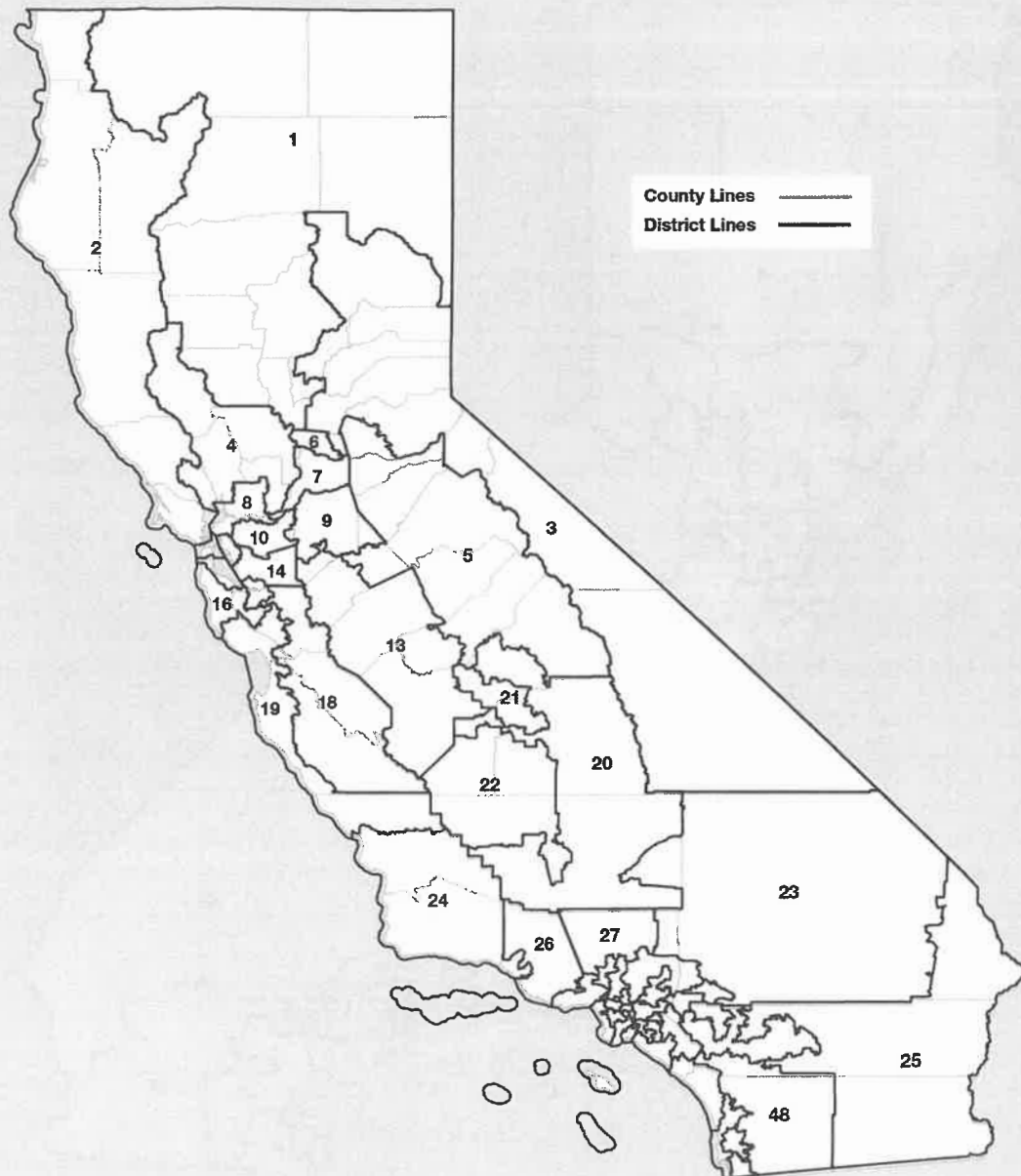

Current Congressional Districts

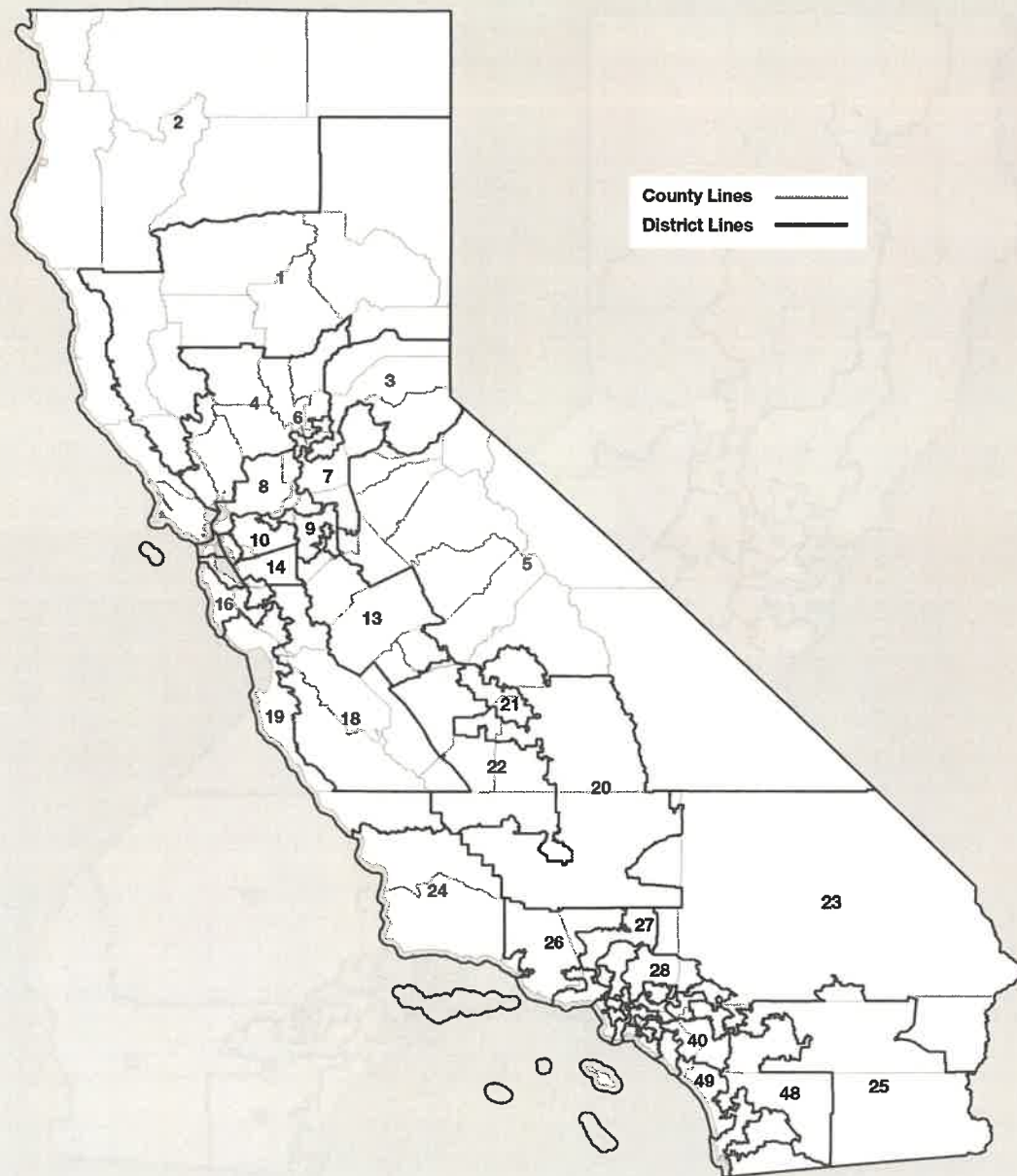

Proposed Congressional Districts



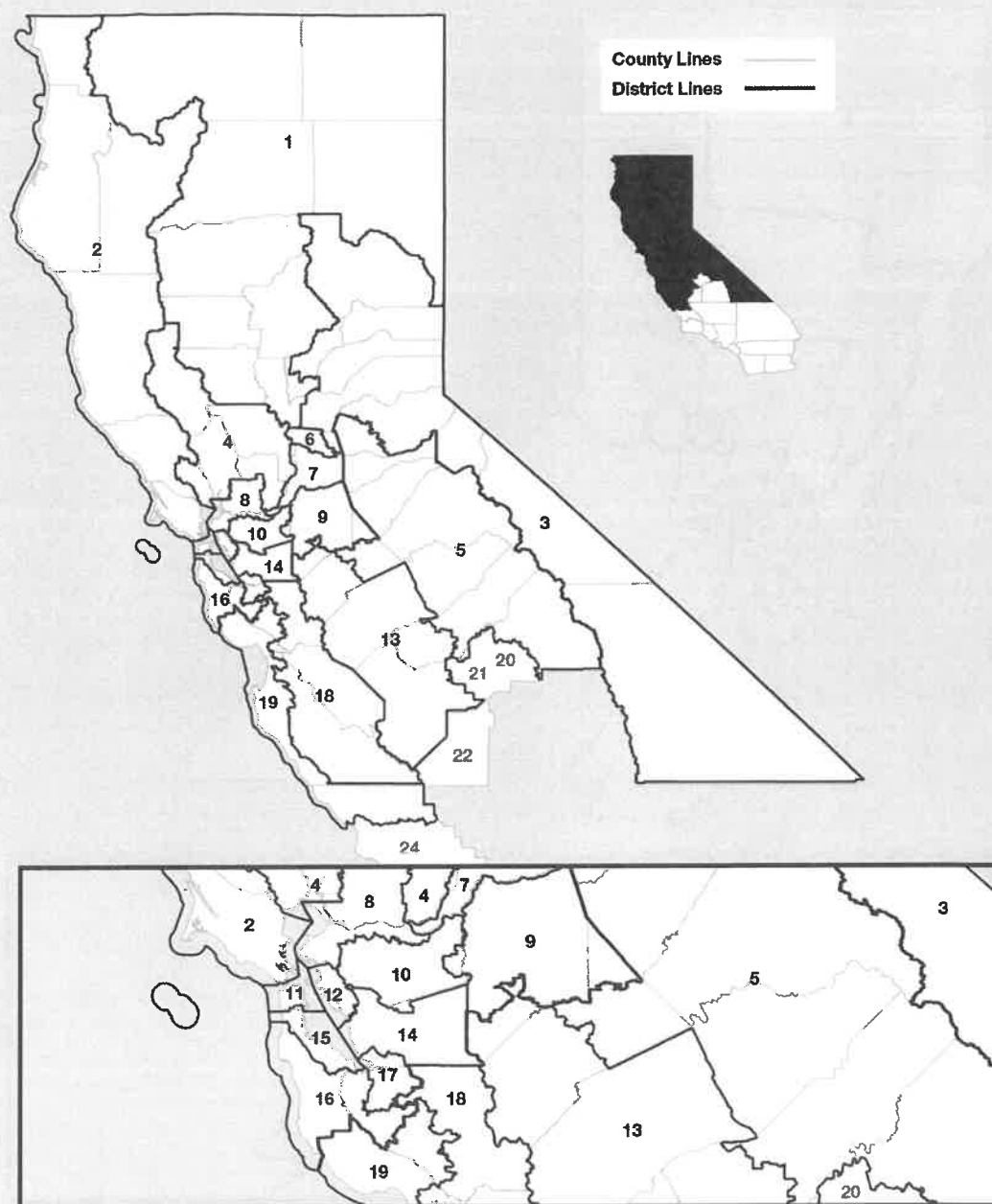

Current Northern Congressional Districts



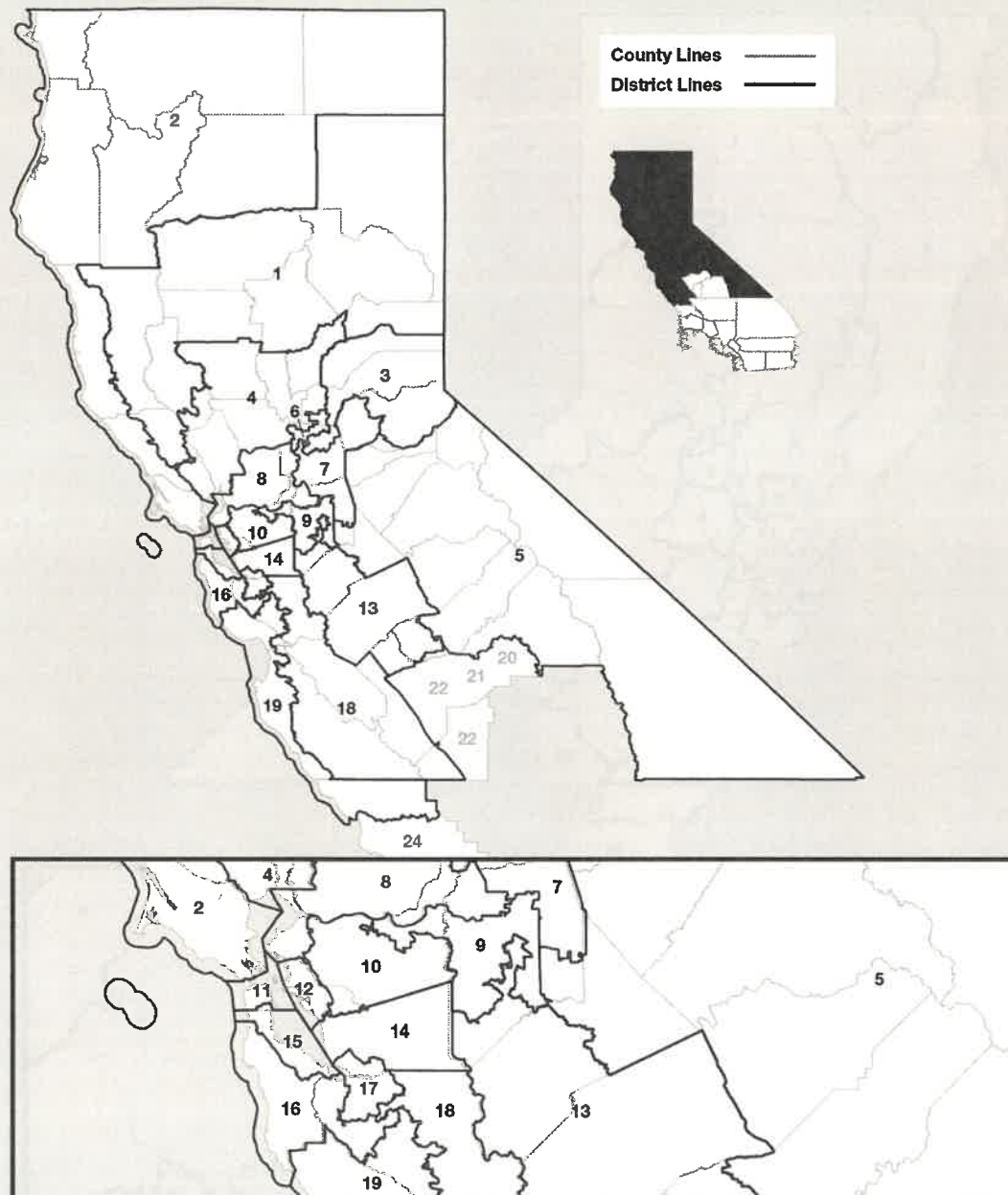

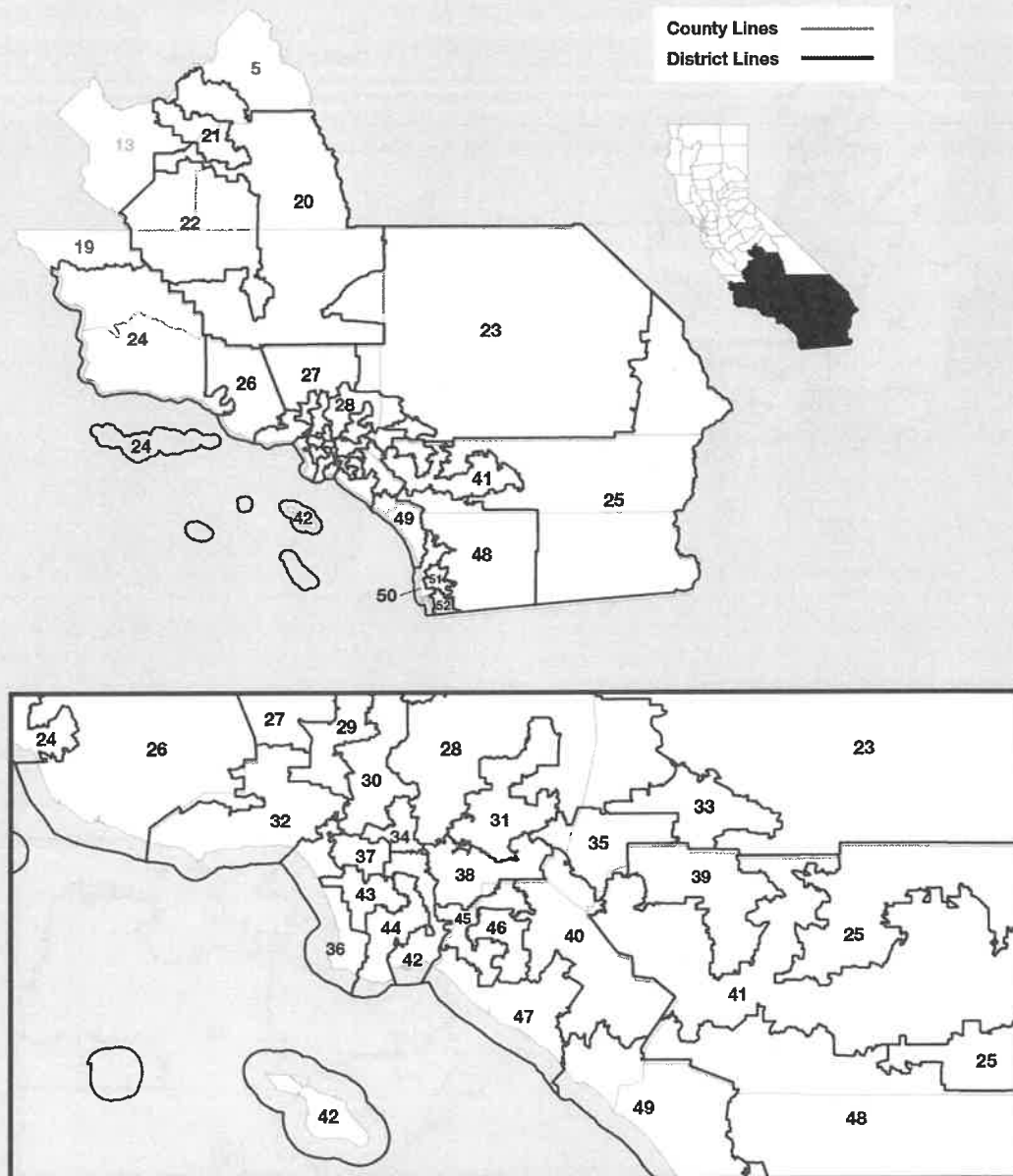
Proposed Northern Congressional Districts

Current Southern Congressional Districts



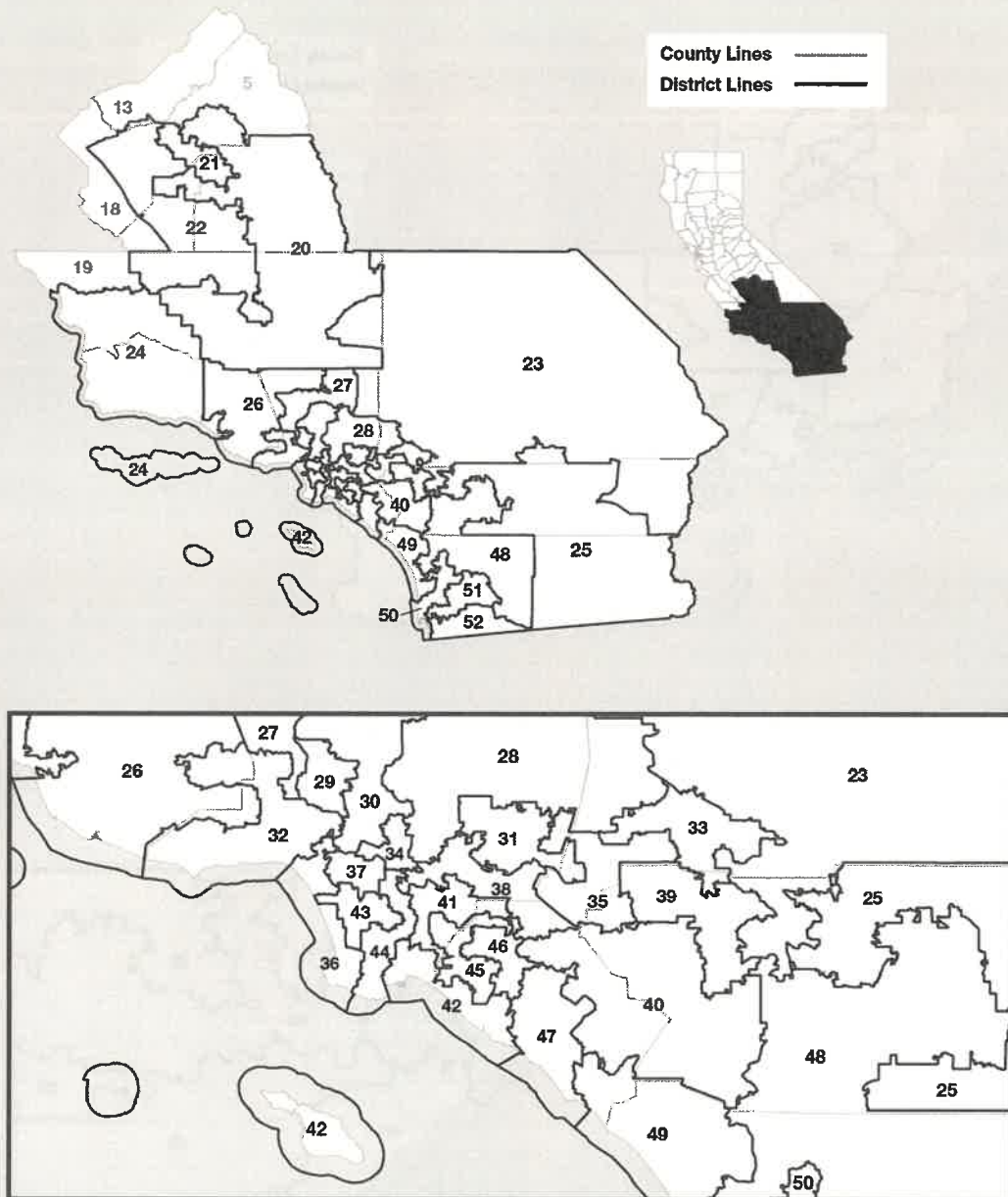
