SUBJECT: League of California Cities Desert Mountain Division 2026 Policy Committee Appointment

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the League of California Cities Desert Mountain Division 2026 Policy Committee Appointment appointing Mayor Pro Tem Josh Pullen to the Public Safety Policy Committee.

BACKGROUND

Cal Cities policy committees review bills or regulatory proposals on issues for which Cal Cities does not have existing policy, or for which staff members feel a policy discussion needs to occur for greater clarity or background on an issue. Staff will lobby legislation, funding proposals, or regulatory changes where existing policy provides clear direction.

The Public Safety Policy Committee reviews issues related to law enforcement, fire and life safety policies, including emergency communications, and emergency services, including ambulance and disaster preparedness. This policy committee meets three times a year. Meetings are scheduled for January, March and June.

ISSUES/ANALYSIS

Individual City Council appointments to outside agency committees are designed to help facilitate a better flow of information between City Council, outside agencies and City staff.
