SUBJECT: Warehouse Commodity – Hydrant, Brass, and Pipe Materials

RECOMMENDED ACTION

It is recommended that the Board Members of the Hesperia Water District authorize the City Manager to approve an annual contract for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-21 to purchase hydrant, brass, and pipe material parts for replacement and repairs in the not-to-exceed amount of \$175,000.

BACKGROUND

The Hesperia Water District established a Formal Request for Bid 2019-20-006 under Warehouse Commodity, Hydrant, Brass, and Pipe Materials in 2020. Bids were sent to six (6) material service providers. Four (4) responses were received: United Water Works, Core & Main, Ferguson Waterworks, and Inland Water Works, from which United Water Works has been deemed to be the lowest responsive/responsible bidder.

ISSUES/ANALYSIS

The intention is to obtain optimum water material pricing by using the formal bidding process and awarding an annual purchase agreement to the lowest responsible/responsive material service provider.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact of this commodity will be serviced out of the warehouse primarily for the Distribution Division under account 700-29-400-4030-7400 and Pipeline Division under account 700-29-400-4035-7400.
